

IVCC DUAL CREDIT PLACEMENT GUIDE

Dual credit placement options for IVCC English, Science, and Math classes

- ✈ **PSAT/ACT/SAT:** Dual credit students may use official PSAT, ACT, and SAT scores for course placement. You will be required to provide a copy of your PSAT score report. When taking the ACT or SAT, be sure to select IVCC to receive your scores; SAT code: 1397; ACT code: 1056. Official scores must be on file with the college prior to registration.
- ✈ **Placement Tests:** IVCC placement tests are another option. Initial testing is free. Appointments are required at least 24 hours in advance. First step to registering for placement testing is an IVCC Dual Credit enrollment form from your high school counselor or the IVCC Dual Credit Coordinator, Susan Monroe, susan_monroe@ivcc.edu. Filling out an enrollment form establishes your IVCC K-Number and student ID number, which are required for placement testing. You will also need a photo ID. Tests can be retaken twice in a 12-month timeframe for a fee. **To schedule a placement testing appointment**, visit <http://www.registerblast.com/ivcc>. - ✈ **GPA:** IVCC does not use grade point average (GPA) for placement of dual credit students.

IVCC has a reading prerequisite for English coursework. The ACT English score of 19 satisfies this component as does the SAT EBRW score. A student must test in both Reading and English if they do not place into English using other placement means.
