

Illinois Valley Community College Phase 5

IVCC made changes on Monday, June 14, 2021, in response to the state's move to Phase 5 of the Governor's Restore Illinois plan. Campus guidelines are as follows:

- Fully-vaccinated students, staff and community members no longer have to wear masks or socially distance.
- Students, staff, and community members who are not fully vaccinated are still expected to wear face masks and practice social distancing.
- Currently the main entrance and the Lot 7 entrance to the main building are open. Temperature checks via thermal scanners are located at each entrance.
- Daily sanitizing of high-touch areas and temperature-monitoring will remain through the summer; contact tracing will be conducted when necessary.
- Use good judgement and if not feeling well stay home and do not attend class.

Health and Safety in Classrooms
