DO YOU HAVE TIME FOR ONLINE LEARNING?

Online classes take as much time, if not more, than the same classes in-person. For every 1 hour spent in the classroom, plan for 2-3 hours of study and assignments. For example:

 \cdot 3 Credit Hour In-Person Class: 3 hours in the classroom + 6-9 hours of work = 9-12 hours per week on one 3-credit hour in-person class.

· 3 Credit Hour Online Class: 3 hours of active online learning (lessons, quizzes, tests,

discussions, etc.) + 6-9 hours of work = 9-12 hours per week on one 3-credit hour online class, with more or less time as needed for mastering the online learning environment.

ONLINE LEARNING ISN'T "EASIER"

- Classes are instructor-led and require specific deadlines for completing tasks and submitting assignments.
- Content in an online class is not "watered down;" an online class has the same outcomes as an in-person class.
- Taking more responsibility for your own learning online can be more challenging than taking a class face-to-face.
- If you do not have enough time to take a class in person, it's likely you do not have enough time to take a class online; set aside time to regularly work on your online class.
- Work with your counselor to determine if online learning is a good option for you.

Required Orientation for Online Students New to IVCC: CSP-0002

Students taking their first online class at IVCC are required to enroll in CSP-0002, a free non-credit, pass/fail online class to help orient students to online learning. Once enrolled, students will be given access to the orientation materials through IVCC's Blackboard system. Students must be checking their IVCC email accounts and IVCC Blackboard to be successful in the online orientation and online classes at IVCC.
