Nomination papers filed by a candidate shall be submitted as directed by the Candidate's Guide and consist of:

1. Statement of Candidacy
2. Petitions for Nomination
 - Candidates name for placement on the ballot will be taken from the top of the first numbered page of nominating petitions
 - No title e.g. Dr. before a name should appear on the petition
 - A minimum of 50 signatures are required on the nominating petitions
 - Nominating petitions are to be properly notarized.
3. Statement of Economic Interest
 - **The statement is required by the Governmental Ethics Act and must be filed with the County Clerk's office to receive a receipt to file with a petition filing during the filing period.**
 - The receipt for filing a Statement of Economic Interest must be for the office in which the candidate is running and filed with the local election official prior to the filing deadline of 5:00 p.m. on November 18, 2024.
4. Loyalty Oath – optional

At the time a candidate submits their nomination papers, they will be required to complete the Code of Fair Campaign Practices document. A copy of the document is available on our website.
