

FAQ'S FOR 2020 CHC WELLBEING HEALTH SCREENING

1. Since this is a “freebie” year and I do not participate will I get the incentive of only paying 20% of the health insurance premium?

No, you still need to participate to qualify. If you do not participate you will be required to pay 22% of health insurance premiums.

1. I am confused on the waiver process, please explain.

The waiver under CHC is the RAS (Reasonable Alternative Standard) and not the Physician form. (The Physician form are for those members who want to go to their own physicians to get their blood drawn.) Yes, it is an option. They would need to contact our member services department at 866-373-4242 to request a RAS form. However, since this is a baseline year, there is no need to get an RAS after they get a blood draw since they don't have a goal they have to achieve. It is participation only this year. The RAS would only be useful for those members who cannot get their blood drawn for some medical reason.

2. When registering, it suggests that immunocompromised people don't screen.

Ultimately it is your choice. If you are immunocompromised you may want to take the route of an RAS form. The Reasonable Alternative Standard is for those members that have a medical reason for not being able to screen.

3. I want to go to my doctor's office for the blood draw, can I do that?

If you want your tests run through a physician office, contact member services department at 866-373-4242 to request a RAS form.
