Policy on Advanced Placement, Transfer of Credits, Credit for Experiential Learning, and Availability of Articulation Agreements

Advanced Placement

The IVCC Medical Assisting Program does not provide for advanced placement into the MA program.

Transfer Students

Students with credits from another medical assisting program may apply. MA credits will be evaluated on a course-by-course basis. All other course credits are subject to IVCC's transfer policies. The following materials must be submitted when requesting a transfer review:

- Letter requesting transfer into the MA program
- College application
- Program application and other requirement (found on the program webpage)
- Official college transcripts, including Medical Assisting courses
- Syllabus and course outline of completed courses for each course completed with a "C" or better

Experiential Learning
