

IVCC Professional Truck Driver Training Certificates

BASIC CERTIFICATE

TDT 1201 - 3 HRS. Credit (Classroom)
TDT 1202 - 7 HRS. Credit (Equipment)

Truck Driver Training students receive 160 hours of driver training. The program uses 10 speed manual transmission and 53-foot dry box van trailers. One instructor to three students during outside equipment training.

Day Class Sessions

- 4 weeks long.
- Monday through Friday | 8:00 AM - 4:30 PM

Night Class Sessions

- 6 weeks long.
- Monday through Friday | 5:00 PM - 10:00 PM

Gain valuable experience in:

- Shifting manual 10 speed
- Log book skills
- Backing skills
- Turning with 53 ft. trailer

The program is appropriate for entry level commercial truck drivers and meets all Federal Motor Carrier Laws. Refresher Program is available to students that need to renew Class A CDL and have experience and hold a valid permit.

ADVANCED TRUCK DRIVER PROFICIENCY CERTIFICATE

This certificate is eligible for students who want to utilize Federal Financial Aid, Pell and MAP Grants or student loans. Students must complete 6 hours of electives prior to enrolling in TDT courses.

TDT REFRESHER TRAINING

This is a 40 hour class covering road driving, yard skills, and pre-trip. Students must have held a CDL in the past 10 years. A driving test is required to qualify for the refresher program.

Offering Federal Mandated Haz-Mat training. Training is offered online and is available monthly.
