- 1. Is IVCC expecting the audit to include manual accessibility testing, automated scanning, or a combination of both approaches?
 - A combination of both approaches.
- 2. If manual testing is required, our typical approach is to audit a representative sample of webpages. Would IVCC be able to suggest an estimated number of sample pages per website that you would consider sufficient?
 - I would suggest 10 pages per site.
- 3. Is there a budget range that has been set aside for this project?

- 4. Should audits and remediation be phased by property (e.g., main site → student publications → intranet), or does IVCC prefer a single concurrent cycle across all properties?
