For early enrollment you must request transcript review during NIU's transfer orientation day and have a 2.50 at time of review. COB strongly recommends taking an Excel course prior to transfer. UBUS110 & 228 can be taken the summer before admission online, ask a NIU advisor (this is not an admission requirement).
