Sciences w/in 5 yrs. <b>3 of the 6 of the following courses to apply:</b> BIO 1003, CHM 1006, CHM 1007, CHM 2002, BIO1007/1008 (count as 1 course) and Biochemistry (UIC has a list of where this can be completed at another school online) MTH 1003;. <b>Other required courses:</b> ENG 1001/1002, SPH 1001, ALH 1000, MTH 1005, PSY 1000, SOC 1000, Understanding Past, Understanding Creative Arts (see UIC Gen ed). HN 1120 & 196 required at UIC before eligible for admission to program. Repeats are averaged. Need foods class (HN110) and biochemistry to stay on track. JJC would have the foods course or it is offered at UIC the summer prior to starting at UIC.
